Dear Parent/Carer

In September 2022, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Loch Primary School and Nursery Class. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school and nursery class work.

- The leadership of the headteacher and principal teacher in leading change. Together they lead TEAM LOCH driven by their high aspirations for all children.
- Caring, compassionate children who proudly ensure that everyone is respected and included in their school.
- The highly effective, nurturing environment where children flourish as a result of the consistent, calm and caring approach of all staff.
- Effective approaches to identifying children who may require additional support with their learning and wellbeing.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from South Lanarkshire Council.

- Continue to ensure all children make appropriate progress in their learning across the curriculum.
- Continue to work together to provide high quality learning experiences across the nursery class and school.

We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using four quality indicators from [How good is our school? \(4<sup>th</sup> edition\)](#) and [How good is our early learning and childcare?](#) Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
