No parents/carers should access the playground between both schools. To avoid congestion at the school gates, we continue to kindly ask that only one parent/carer drops off and collects your child and that once your child enters/leaves the school you leave the area immediately to avoid overcrowding before St. Anthony's PS exit.

Please keep this in mind when you are sending your child to school with a snack/packed lunch. Attendance and Time-Keeping



Attendance at school is crucial to support children's progress, wellbeing and attainment. Please remember that should your child be unwell it is important that you contact the School Office on 0141 634 7217 or via the school app and leave a message stating the cause of absence and possible date of return. In accordance with SLC Policy we must contact parents/carers if we have not been informed of a reason for a child being absent from nursery or school.

It is equally important that each child arrives at the school in time for the bell to ring at their allocated start time. We understand that everyone can, on occasion, sleep in and run late for school for many reasons. however regular lateness can be very disruptive to your child's education. Please remember that your child will be marked as 'unauthorised' should they go on holiday during term time.

School Improvement/PEF Update



- Mrs McKee attended the 'Bookbug Shared Practice Event' on 1.11.22, liaising with colleagues about the implementation of the Bookbug programme.
- Miss Simpson has visited all classes to look at the development of writing across all stages. The children engaged very well and showed great enthusiasm and participation!
