## Attendance and Time-Keeping



Attendance at school is crucial to support children's progress, wellbeing and attainment. If your child is absent, it is important that you contact the School Office on 0141 634 7217 or via the school app to report this absence. In accordance with SLC Policy we must contact parents/carers if we have not been informed of a reason for a child being absent.

It is equally important that your child arrives at school on time. We understand that everyone can, on occasion, sleep in and run late for school for many reasons, however regular lateness can be very disruptive to your child's education. Please remember that your child will be marked as 'unauthorised' should they go on holiday during term time.

### Health and Safety (



As we have children with severe allergies, please remember that we are a 'NUT FREE' school and nursery. Should your child bring a snack with nuts in it, the Class Teacher/nursery staff will keep it until the end of the day and return it for your child to eat at home. Thank you for your help and support with this matter.

As you will be aware, headlice can cause problems both at home or in school. Please try to check your child's hair regularly and if you see any headlice, it is recommended that you treat both them and the whole family.

#### School Improvement/PEF Update



- Miss Simpson and Miss Harrington have met with nursery and school staff to discuss the strategies in place to support children's learning and development.
- Mrs Burns has attended 'Nurturing Interventions' and 'Young Minds' training to support our whole school nurture work.
- Mrs Main has attended Nurture UK training this month. This means that 12 staff have now received this accredited training.
- 5 members of staff have received Catch Up Literacy training to enable the delivery of this intervention to support us in our aim of raising attainment in Literacy.
- Our nursery staff have undertaken a range of training this month including 'Getting Ready to Read', 'Communication and Language, 'ASD' and 'Numeracy'.
- Miss Simpson attended Child Protection Coordinator training on 8.3.23.
- Listening and Talking visits have been carried out in all classes to observe teaching, learning and progression.
- Mrs Munro has continued to participate in 'Play Based Learning' training, looking at ways to embed this approach within the classroom.
- Miss Simpson attended 'Pupil Equity Funding' training to discuss the reporting process to describe the positive impact this funding has had on children's learning and development.
- Mrs Henderson and Miss Harrington participated in 'Maths Recovery' training to support our work in implementing this resource across the school.
- Miss Simpson has continued to participate in the South Lanarkshire Council 'Cost of the School Day' Working Party, working with colleagues from across SLC to develop a council wide policy.

- Miss Simpson attended the 'Early Learning and Childcare Head Teacher Meeting' on 22.3.23 to keep up-to-date with new initiatives and programmes within Early Years.
- Miss Simpson attended the 'Head Teacher Meeting' on 23.2.23, looking at Racial Equality and Anti-Racist Education in practice and supports available for learning/wellbeing.
- Mrs Thomson attended First Aid training on 23.3.23.

#### Primary 1-7 Book of the Month

Each month your child will receive a 'Book of the Month' for them to keep at home. This book will be free as we will be using our Pupil Equity Funding to support the development of reading and to help us promote reading for enjoyment.
