Attendance is crucial to supporting children's progress, wellbeing and attainment. Your child's attendance rate has a significant impact on their attainment and achievements:

Being at school on time each day is also crucial to your child's progress and learning. Did you know that being 15 minutes late every day, will result in your child missing approximately 50 hours of teaching per year? We greatly encourage everyone to try their best to be at school on time for the bell ringing at 9:00am to ensure your child can make the most of their education.

Primary 1 Enrolment 2026



The infant enrolment process for children due to start school in August 2026, will start from 5th January 2026. Parents/carers should enrol children from 5th January 2026 using the online registration form available on the SLC website.

To enrol your child, you will need to upload the following documents:

- Your child's full birth certificate.
- Two recent official documents showing your permanent home address. This should be dated no later than the past 6-month period (for example, a utility bill, Council Tax statement this should be the statement for the current year, housing rent card, child benefit documentation). Proof of where the child lives may also be requested.
