Dear parent/carer,

I hope your child enjoyed their first day in Primary 1 and had fun meeting their teacher and friends. Everyone looked very smart in their school uniforms! I am sure they will enjoy being part of TEAM LOCH!

From tomorrow (Friday 14th August), **your child should attend school 9:00am – 2:55pm and should enter the school via the rear gate as detailed below.**

Mrs Kennedy will be working across all classes, covering teacher's non class contact time. Mrs Burns will be working within our Sunshine Room.

School hours are as follows:

- School day: 9:00am – 2:55pm
- Break: 10:35am – 10:45am
- Lunch: 12:15pm – 1:00pm

Entry Arrangements:

All children enter the school via the large/main playground gate at the rear of the school at the turning point between Loch PS and St. Anthony's PS. The children will line up in their classes and will be met by their teacher at 9:00am. The school gates will open at 8:50am when there will be a staff presence.

Exit Arrangements:

All children exit the school via the same gate as they enter the school. The Class Teachers will lead each class to the gate. Prior to school drop off, please let your child know who is due to collect them from school. This helps them to easily spot who is there at the end of the day. We kindly ask that all parents/carers wait further back from the outside gate until their child's

class approaches to allow for the Class Teachers to safely dismiss the children to their parent/carer. To avoid congestion, we kindly ask that once your child enters/leaves the school you leave the area immediately to avoid overcrowding before St. Anthony's PS exit.

As you can imagine, the school office is very busy at the end of the day and calls cannot always be answered. If for any reason you are going to be late to collect your child, please contact the school as soon as possible to ensure your child does not leave the school grounds. We also kindly ask that you do not collect another child unless this has previously been arranged with the parent/carer and the school has been informed.

Uniform:

- At Loch PS we are very proud of our school community and we encourage all pupils to wear our school uniform. If you require support with this, please contact the school office. It is our intention to provide outdoor learning opportunities as much as possible and therefore ask that pupils bring a pair of shoes and wear a jacket/raincoat suitable for the outdoors.
- We ask that children bring a change of shoes for indoors (gym shoes) if possible. These indoor shoes can remain within the school.
- Each child will be provided with stationery and everything they need to use within school. Children are allowed to bring their own pencil case if they wish.

Lunches:

- Lunches will be eaten within the school dining hall.
- Pupils are allowed to bring their own packed lunch from home if they wish.

- As per SLC guidance, free school meals are available for all pupils in Primary 1 to 5. Pupils in Primary 6 and 7 pay £2.71 per meal which should be paid via Parent Pay. If your child is in Primary 6 or Primary 7, they may still qualify for free school meals if you receive certain benefits. - Children are allowed to bring a water bottle to school to have within their class. This should be filled with plain water only.
- We are a health promoting school and we kindly ask that your child does not bring fizzy juice with them to school.
- Due to severe allergies within the school, we are a nut-free school. Please ensure you check your child's snacks and lunch to ensure there are no products that contain nuts.

Class information:

Your child's teacher will inform you of homework procedures. The PE timetable is as follows:
